H. 5237. "Samond" sailed from Bombay on May 25th. with 30 Samonds
for deportation to Ceylon.

These men were embarked on the ss. "Coconada" at Bombay on May
14th. by the General Officer Commanding Force "B" under instructions
from Protectorate authorities and arrived with other details at
Bombay on 22nd. May.
