I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Read's letter of the 12th instant (6852/1915), and its enclosures further relative to the local legislation required in order to enable the Government of the East Africa Protectorate to borrow under the East African Protectorates (Loans) Act, 1914.

In reply, I am directed to request you to inform Mr. Secretary Harcourt that They concur in the roads programme as now revised and in the proposed change in the title of the item previously described as "Additions to Lake Fleet" to "Marine Works and Shipping Facilities, Lake Victoria".

My Lords will be prepared to make an advance, within the limit of £80,000 already agreed, in respect of loan commitments already incurred, on the receipt of telegraphic assurances from the Governors of the three Protectorates that the Ordinances have been passed in the terms approved.
