WEST AFRICA. (3) General Sir Horace Smith-Dorrien should receive instructions in the sense that, prior to the next rainy season in East Africa, he is to undertake an offensive-defensive with the object of expelling the enemy from British territory and safeguarding it against further incursions. The decision as to the ultimate scope of the offensive operations to be undertaken against German East Africa after the rainy season should be postponed until General Sir Horace Smith-Dorrien has reported in the light of the experience gained before the rainy season.
