Sir,

In reference to the arrangements come to between the Company and the East Africa Protectorate government with the sanction of the Secretary of State, we shall be grateful if you will request the East Africa Protectorate government to expedite the promulgation of Ordinance to exempt all electric plant, machinery, and material from Customs duty as from 1st. June 1914, in accordance with the agreement come to, and as shewn more particularly in the letter No. S.4135 II of 8th. January 1914 from the Chief Secretary to the East Africa Protectorate government to us and our acceptance of the terms thereof dated 9th. January 1914: as delay in so doing will upset our calculation and arrangement of financial provision necessary for the execution of the works and installing the additional plant so urgently required.
