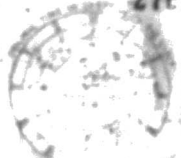

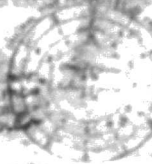

291 30th May My telegram 15th May

260 following telegram has been received from
Officer Commanding Troops Turkana dated 18th May
begins well organised force Abyssinians approximately
250 rifles entered Dodosa attacked and captured
Loyere post about 18th May raided 300 head cattle
hundred denkeys. During the night 16th May
raiders left Dodosa via Nakoti pass surrounding my
patrol of fifteen men few miles to the east of pass
six fortyfive a.m. 17th May. I arrived on
scene seven a.m. with 22 rifles and succeeded in
extricating patrol. Close desperate fighting lasted
until eleven twenty-five a.m. my losses four killed
eight wounded one rifle. Abyssinian heavy losses.
Personally counted 37 Amhara Abyssinians one Swahili
leader four of other tribes. Many Abyssinians
wounded. Heavily handicapped by wounded we made
no attempt to recapture saddle. Anticipating above had
sent for B company which could not join up until
eight hours after fight. B company now proceeding
to Railhead, situation here easier. Important you
should arrange for Officer Commanding Battalion
replace casualties immediately and consider should
have extra subaltern eqds. Stores and relief being
sent. Will discuss matter with Hoskins this week
and report further in due course.
