I have the honour to refer to the stalegraphic correspondence respecting the grant of assistance to the dependents of local residents serving in the East African forces ending with your telegram of May 15th and to report as follows on the result of this

Concession.

- 2. On the receipt of your telegram the War Council took steps to acquaint the officers commanding the various local units with the terms on which assistance could be granted and requested that they should be communicated to their men.
- Thirty-six applications have been received so far, of which twenty have been rejected and six remain under consideration.

In eight cases a monthly allowance of £5 has been recommended and sanctioned and in 2 a monthly allowance of £2.

- 4. The expenditure in connection with the scheme is therefore £44 per mensem, and the total for the current financial year, provided that it is necessary to continue payments till then will be approximately £46
- further grants involving additional expendit but I think I should be well within the mark if I put the final figure for the year at £1000 as against the £5250 suggested as a possible outside estimate in my telegram No. 248 of May 10th.
