PARAPHRASE

TELEGRAM from the ~~Office~~ ^{Office} Administering the Government of the East Africa Protectorate to the Secretary of State for the Colonies.

Dated 24th September, 1917.

(Received Colonial Office 11.30 p.m. 24/9/17.)

September 24th. With reference to your cipher telegram of September 21st on the return of the Attorney General at the end of the week I will reply further.

With reference to latter portion of your telegram, Commissioner of Police has under orders issued by the Governor to him on March 24th, been corresponding direct with Colonel Kell without reference to this Government on the subject of Swedish activities. Propose to countermand those orders and to instruct him that any further information should be communicated to me.

I find that the proposal in paragraph 3 of the Governor's Secret semi-official despatch of December 2nd 1915 to the Under Secretary of State has been acted on. Please inform me whether that procedure is to continue.
