

Statements of Railway and Port Works Expenditure, 1st.

October 1913 to 31st. March 1914 (E.A.P.50398/14) and
1st. April to 30th September 1914 (E.A.P.49/14-15).

I have examined the above statements of Railway and Port Works expenditure, as furnished to the Colonial Office by the Magadi Soda Company and, subject to the deduction of £1,000 overcharged in respect of Consulting Engineers' Fees and of £667:10:0 representing expenditure under Messrs: Pauling and Co: 's Contract not yet allowed by the Consulting Engineers, I find the total expenditure to the 30th September 1914, (as recorded in the later statement) to be correct.

2. In further explanation of the overcharge of £1000, above referred to, I would mention that, in accordance with the agreement between Messrs: Livesey and Henderson and the Magadi Soda Company, a total fee of £12,000 became due to the former in return for their services as Consulting Engineers for the Railway and Port Works Construction. The further sum of £1,000, inadvertently charged by the Company to the Railway and Port Works Capital Account, represents remuneration for extra services rendered by the Consulting Engineers in connection with the Company's Soda Factory. I went into this question with the Secretary of the Company who promptly arranged for the elimination of this overcharge from future statements of Expenditure to be rendered to the Colonial Office.

3. Except in the case of the charge of £667:10:0 to which I have referred above (paragraph 1) all outstanding

ing questions raised in my report on the accounts for the half year ended the 30th September 1913 have now been satisfactorily settled.

4. With reference to paragraph 3 of my report on the account for the year ended 31st March 1913 (E.A.P. 29700/13) the proportion of certified expenditure due to Messrs: Pauling and Company, but retained by the Magadi Soda Company pending completion of contract, has been recorded for the first time in the statement of expenditure to 30th September 1914.
