Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 27th ultimo, No. 61321/16 in which you transmitted copy of a telegram from the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate, relative to the export of tanning substances and extracts to France, Russia, Italy and to Japan, I am instructed by the Director of the War Trade Department to state for the information of Mr Secretary Long, that if wattle bark is excepted from the proposal, this Department will have no objection to the Governor being given general authority as suggested in the second paragraph of your letter.

I wish to suggest that in view of home requirements the Governor should be asked to encourage the shipment of wattle bark to the United Kingdom as far as possible.
