Sir,

In continuation of my letter of the 25th August last with reference to a Memorandum by the Commissioner of Mines in the East Africa Protectorate on the possibilities of development of certain mineral resources of the Protectorate, I enclose Memoranda on (1) cement manufacture in the Protectorate and (2) roofing materials suitable for use in that country.

In the Memorandum on cement manufacture, it is suggested that samples of the raw materials should be forwarded to the Imperial Institute for technical trial. After such trials have been carried out, it will be possible to make further suggestions as to the possibility of establishing a cement-making industry in the Protectorate.
