TELEGRAM from the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate to the Secretary of State for the Colonies.

(Dated 6th July.)

(Received Colonial Office 9.25 p.m. 13th July, 1919.)

July 6th. No. 547. Land settlement your telegram of 27th June recommend that regulation forbidding to hold land in the East Africa Protectorate be waived for purpose of this scheme both for King's African Rifles staff and civil servants who are qualified to apply for lease despatch 4th April 1919 para 7. Qualified civil servants have been accepted here and await your necessary sanction take up their allotments (sanction take up their allotments). Grant of occupation permit implies obligation to pay rent from date of issue land refers to Crown if titles not taken out before July 1st 1921. Position of regular officers can be considered then if necessary. My telegram 26th May 427 correct reading is 1,261 to 75 1,287 to 1,309.
