With reference to correspondence ending with your letter of 8th April 1919, No. 19643/19, regarding the supply of currency notes from India to East Africa, I am directed to state for the information of Lord Milner that the 50 rupee notes reported by the Deputy Governor of the East African Protectorate to have been returned to India are now reported to have been received on 7th June last.
