Please see minutes on 28550. It appears that General Horstey took a personal interest in these cases, and it certainly seems to me that the deeds of gallantry described in 38550 would justify the award by the R. of S. for the Colonies of the K.A.P. D.C.M. to the three n.c.o's mentioned. As you point out in your minute on 28550 there are precedents in the case of the Somaliland Camel Corps. ^{in giving} They gave the K.A.R. D.C.M. to ^{native} soldiers who did not actually belong to the K.A.R. I think the K.A.R. D.C.M. should therefore be given in these three cases. The only objection is that we always claim that the K.A.P. D.C.M. is equivalent in its way to the Imperial D.C.M. and that to give it in cases where the W.O. have declined to approve the Imperial D.C.M. would look as if we had abandoned this attitude. But there is no reason why we should let it be known that the W.O. have declined to approve the Imperial D.C.M. to these three men.
