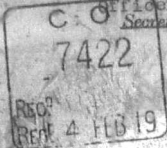

In reply to your letter No 1474 of the 14th instant, on the subject of the retired pay of Lieutenant D. Filtness, late King's Rifle Corps, I am directed by the Minister of Pensions to inform you that this officer was awarded temporary retired pay up to the 4th ultimo, and that the sum of £14.9.10. still due on that date can now be paid to him locally by the Colonial Treasurer.

I am to add that on the 23rd October last a request was sent to the Headquarters of the Military Command, British East Africa, to arrange for a medical board on Lieutenant Filtness. As soon as the report of that board on Army Form A 45 is received, the renewal of retired pay from the 5th ultimo will be considered, and arrangements will be made for payment in British East Africa of the retired pay that may be awarded.
