With reference to your letter of the 17th January 1919 Reference No. 2952/1919 on the subject of the pension of Mr. C.K. Hilton, late L/Corporal, No. 228, East African Mounted Rifles, I have the honour to inform you that the Medical Report has now been received and Mr. Hilton's disability has been assessed at 30%. This would entitle him to an award of 8/3 a week for a further period of 6 months. Additional Allowances are paid in cases where further Medical Treatment is required.
