I have the honor to request that before the expiration of my sick leave on 12th February, I may be medically examined for fitness to serve in East Africa, and that should I be found fit, I may be allowed to relinquish my appointment in the East African Political Dept. as I am still subject to malarial attacks and do not think I can stand the climatical present.

I would also request that enquiries may be made from East Africa with a view to the payment of my War bonus. With the exception of a few months spent on my farm on what was called "indefinite leave" I served continuously throughout the War in East Africa until I was invalided in 1918.
