Mr. Pearless I know can give a good account of himself in Land Survey operations, and I have tested him to some extent in the usual trigonometrical calculations, computation of areas, adjustment of instruments etc. If it is necessary for Mr. Pearless to acquire better knowledge in any ordinary branch of surveying he may be required to undertake on Foreign Service, I am sure he would soon qualify for it.

I have employed several surveyors of Mr. Pearless's type here who have not sat for a license, and they have done well for me in open and forest field work, and have been expeditious and economical.

I am quite sure that if Mr. Pearless is given an appointment he will give satisfaction to his employers, and if there is any occasional complicated mathematical problem, so rarely met with in everyday work, he will only have to ask for assistance from his Chief at Head Office.

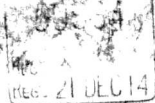
