Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that Messrs. A. de V. Wade, C. M. Castle-Smith, C. H. F. Plowman and G. H. C. Boulderson, Assistant District Commissioners, will complete their period of 3 years probationary service on March 28th.

2. The work of these officers has been in every way satisfactory and they have passed the prescribed tests in language and law with the exception of Mr. Wade, who has yet to qualify in Swahili and Mr. Castle-Smith, who has not yet passed in law.

3. I have therefore the honour to submit their names for admission to the permanent establishment of the Protectorate Messrs. Plowman and Boulderson immediately and Messrs. Wade and Castle-Smith subject to their passing the examination in Swahili and Law respectively.
