No. 1434. Your telegram 28th April on January 1st there were ten vacancies vice staff list. All these have been filled up including Rayne. Two subsequent vacancies have occurred vice Pitt and Athill. Has not yet been possible to relieve latter in A. F. D. but expect to do so shortly. New estimates provide four additional Assistant District Commissioners. Owing to demands of military authorities consider all six vacancies should be filled up as soon as possible and recommend Francklin be selected for one of them.
