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My Lords do not in the circumstances wish to offer any comment on the proposals of the Government of India and They concur accordingly in the draft reply. They would suggest, however, that it should be made clear that this arrangement only applies to stores which are a final charge on Protectorate Funds and does not cover stores advanced immediately to a Protectorate Government but ultimately charged to War Office or Admiralty Votes.
