WIDOWS' AND ORPHANS' PENSIONS SCHEME.
CONTRIBUTIONS OF MR. J. M. ROAD.

As more than three months elapsed between his appointment to Kenya and his transfer to the Uga. Rly, option to discontinue his contributions was not open to him. Mr. Road must either be exempted from contributing from the beginning or must continue to contribute.

REMARKS

The reference to 3 months comes from Section 4 of the Ordinance. It says that no officer shall be allowed to contribute during the absence of a dependant. If an officer is absent from duty for more than three months he shall be liable to contribute. It is pointed out that as Mr. Road was transferred to the Uga. Rly. before he was transferred to the Uga. Rly. he had not the opportunity of discontinuing his contributions. It is suggested that he should be exempted from contributing from the beginning of his service in Kenya.
