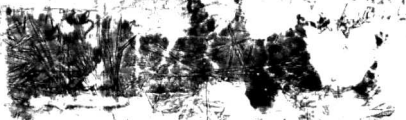

I discussed this with Mr. Jeffries  
 and agree with the action proposed.  
 In regard to Nyasaland, I think  
 £1200 is a fair salary for the  
 Director - and on the 15th I have  
 suggested that Mr. MacCallum should be  
 asked to allow £1200 as a provisional  
 figure, pending a further letter from  
 us on the general question.

I would have the Sanitation Officer  
 in Nyasaland where he is (£800-1000).  
 Owing to lack of funds sanitation  
 work is rudimentary in Nyasaland.  
 Dr. Sanderson, the present holder, will  
 be retiring soon, and the question  
 of putting up the salary may well  
 arise for a year or two.

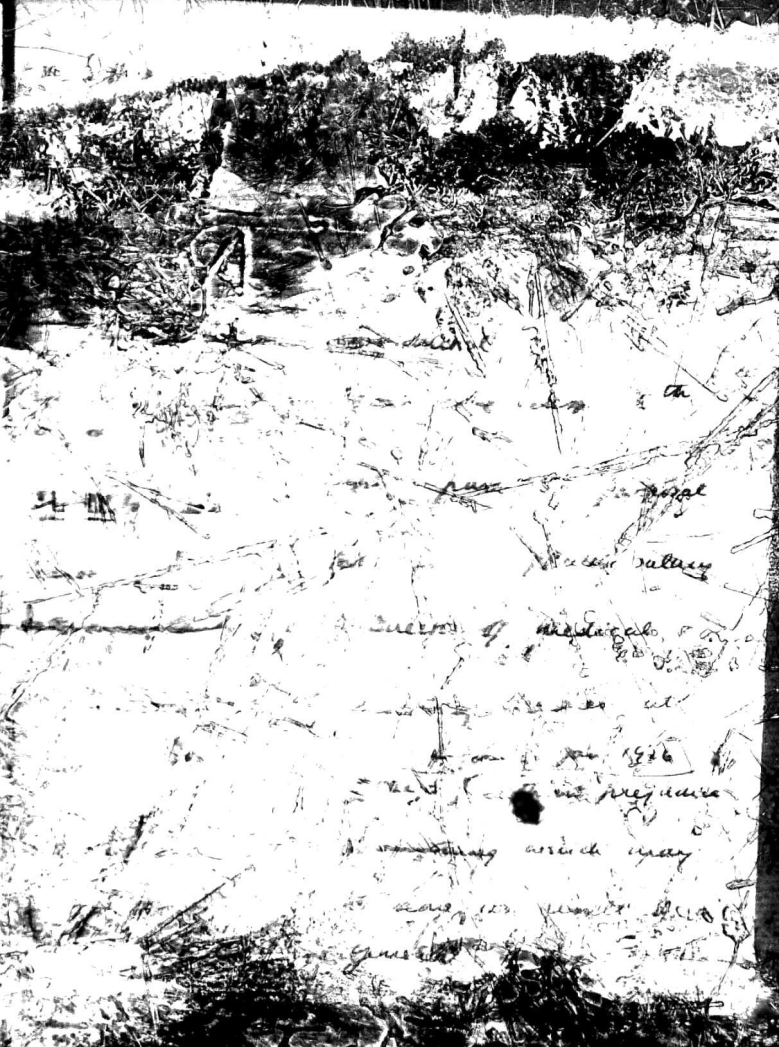
