The position has changed considerably since the last review on 17/16/24

One 1st Grade Officer has been promoted (another has retired) & another is returning shortly.

For 2nd Grade Officers have gone up to the 1st Grade and Plowmen. Edwards is Secretary hence removed out of the list of 2nd Grade Officers.

On the other hand, on the Estimates, the number of 1st Grade Officers have been reduced by 4 & the number of 2nd Grade by one.

Further, 6 2nd Grade Officers are shown as seconded to other Dept.

The establishment of 2nd Grade Officers stands at 70, others appear to be 66 Officers holding such appointments, leaving 4 vacancies. The Governor, however, has some local candidates, or may not want to fill some or all of the vacancies, & I think we had better
