In reply to Sir G. Grindle's letter of the 30th September last (45469/1924), I am directed by the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury to request you to inform the Secretary of State for the Colonies that They sanction the continuance until the 31st March 1926 of the concession whereby the allowances granted under the revised conditions of service to officers of the East African Dependencies with salaries not exceeding £500 a year, towards the cost of their wives' and families' passages, are extended to officers with salaries up to £700 a year. Should the Secretary of State not be in a position to submit definite proposals by the end of March 1926 as to the continuance or otherwise of local allowances, My Lords agree that the concessions authorized above may be continued after the

31st
