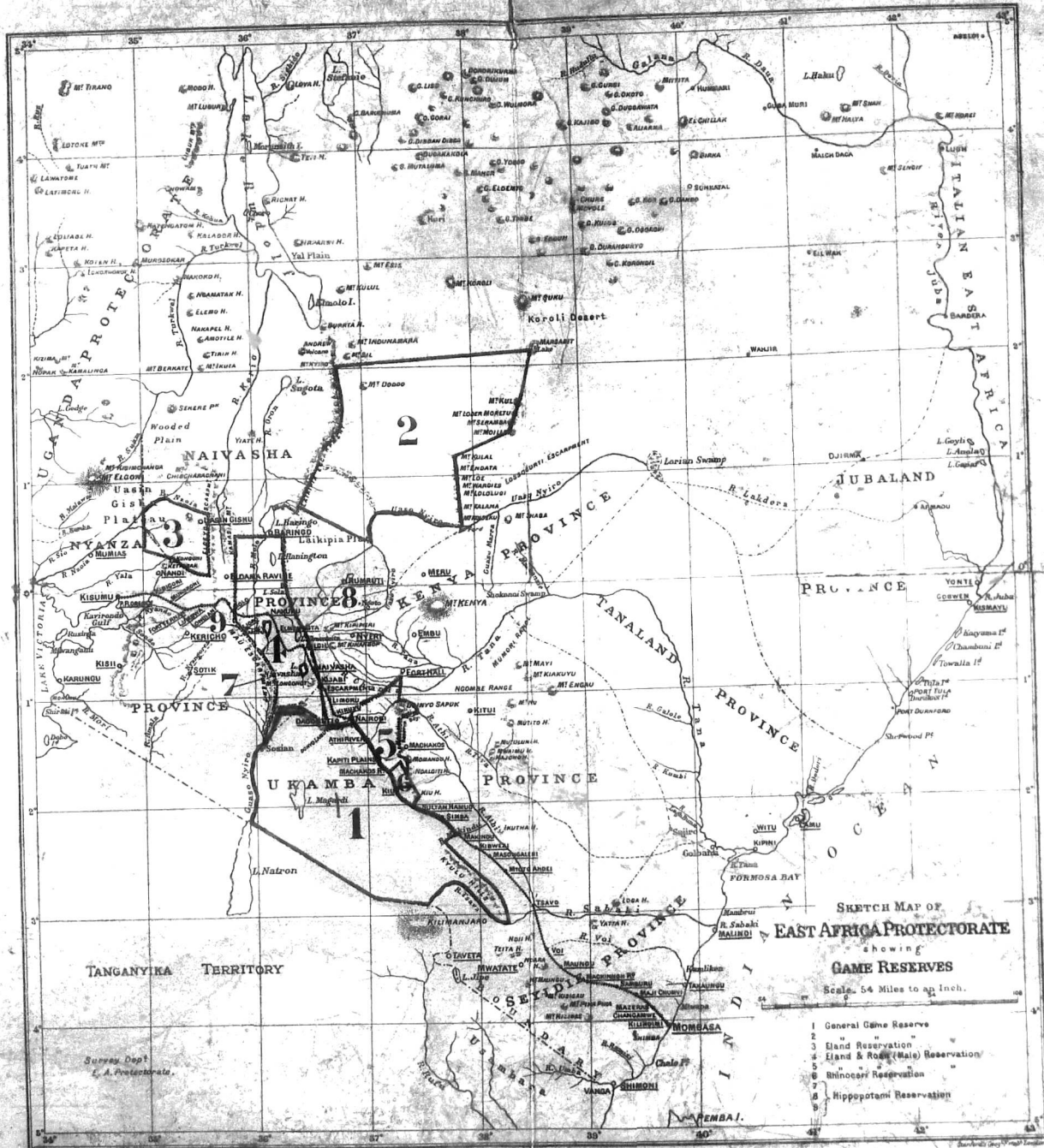
With reference to your letter of the 26th inst., I have pleasure in forwarding a copy of the map of the East African Game Reserves. This copy is a proof from a block which we have already had made, though naturally its publication is subject to your permission. We regret that the original has been accidentally mislaid, and we have not yet been able to trace it; the only differences between it and the present proof are that in the original the outlines of the reserves were in red, Tanganyika Territory was called German East Africa, and the date 1910 appeared in the left-hand bottom corner; the size of the map remains the same.

We should be most grateful if we might have an early decision on this matter as the Spring publishing season is rapidly drawing to an end.
