It must be observed that if action is not taken to stop this breach, then in view of Clause 4 of the draft. Port Lease the new lagred Company will have conveyed to them a property with an existing and continues breach of the lease under which it is a granted and conveyed. This will place them in the position of having Government entitled to reenter at any time. But there is the complication that any failure to not now would probably result in Covernment beinggestopped, in taking action then and thus Clause 4 of the draft port Lease mould be rendered nugatory.
