The Under Secretary of State

Sir,

I have the honour to enquire if sanction has already been given to the appointment of a third Queen Judge for the East Africa Protectorate.

I am quite satisfied that the appointment of another Queen Judge is most essential for the work of the High Court to be properly and expeditiously carried out. Apart from delays which under present circumstances occur in trying cases, for a very considerable period it has not been possible for the Court to inspect adequately the records of Subordinate Courts. Such inspection is a duty placed on the High Court by Ordinance, and I am convinced that it is a very useful function giving great assistance when carried out to the District Commissioners and others who hold Subordinate Courts. It also helps to clear up a vast amount of misapprehension regarding the relationship between the High Court and the Administration. I am, Sir, The Queen's etc
