Salary - £2000 to £2700.

Pension - Pension is drawn by
a med. officer in acc^{ce} with
the E. African Pension
Reg^{ns}, a copy of wh. is
enclosed. ~~but~~ Since the
present edition of the Reg^{ns}
was printed the age for
retirement with out medical
certif. is fifty or after
twenty years Colonial
Service, whichever is

greater, and retirement
is compulsory as well as
voluntary on reaching the
age of retirement, but an
officer may be retained in
the service beyond that age,
with his own consent, for
such further period as the
Gov. may recommend.

Gratuity - a med. officer
may retire, if he wishes,
and draw a gratuity in
lieu of pension, after
9 years service (of which
6 years must be resident
service in E. Afr.) or after
12 years service (of which

4 years must be resident
service in Capricorn). The
gratuity is £1000 after 9
years service & £1250 after
12 years service.

4. The General Comd^{rs} ~~is~~ who
governs the employment of
Imperial officials in E. Africa.
The leave reg^s are shown
in the attached pamphlets
(Capricorn 973 & 974).
A copy of the Col. Reg^s is also
enclosed.

5. If you were selected for
a permanent appt., your
temporary service as a
K. O. would ultimately be

included as service for
retirement purposes (see 473
gratuity). If you retire
in civil relationship you to
pension (or gratuity),
provided that there is no
break between the
temporary service & service
with the parent estate.
