It is estimated expenditure with additional laboratory staff & other labor would endeavor to supply 5000 doses monthly during 12 months pending completion of new building & plant machinery. The prospect of procuring control vaccine from certain island territories is being considered.

Telegram from the Officer Administering the Government of the East Africa Protectorate to the Secretary of State for the Colonies

Dated 3rd February.

56 3rd February Your telegram 21st January Veterinary laboratory unable to manufacture 500,000 doses rinderpest serum in period thirty three months without incurring considerable capital and current expenditure. Estimated expenditure as follows additions: building plant machinery 26,200 laboratory supplies equipment 21,400 cost of cattle and maintenance 213,000 staff and labour 24,400 maintenance of plant sundry supplies 24,000 total 230,000. Requirements under first head cannot be erected under twelve months. With additional laboratory supplies staff and labour, would use every endeavour to supply 5,000 doses per month during next twelve months pending completion of new building plant and machinery. Cost of supplying this quantity can be met out of expenditure vote. Thought that unless Uganda Protectorate able to increase staff Veterinary Officers this supply might suffice present needs. It should be understood that no serum can be supplied unless necessary control cattle are procurable. All possible sources of supply being investigated hoped Uganda could supply but cannot. There is fair prospect of procuring them from certain islands Victoria Nyanza. Acting Chief Veterinary Officer German East Africa now investigating and information would be available in about 14 days. Cost of production of rinderpest serum estimated at eighty cents per dose 50 cubic centimetres propose charge Uganda Protectorate this rate.
