I have the honour to forward herewith a form of particulars required for the computation of a pension to Mr. C. K. Patel, a II Grade Clerk in the Treasury Department, who has been pronounced unfit for further service in this Colony by a Medical Board held on him at Nairobi on the 10th November, 1920. 


