Following telegram is sent at the request of Indian Congress begins - Indian Congress Committee humbly submits that Traders Licensing Ordinance 1919 which came into operation on January 1st will prove to be absolutely destructive Indian trade in East Africa. Indian community most strongly protests and prays for withholding from sanction and immediate suspension until consideration of my Committee's representations which are being forwarded.
