LEAVE AND RETURN  
LEAVE AGREEMENT.**

**Agreement** made this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_  
One thousand nine hundred and \_\_\_\_\_  
BETWEEN

In the County of \_\_\_\_\_ of the one part,  
and THE CROWN AGENTS FOR THE COLONIES,  
London, in the County of Middlesex, for and on behalf of His  
Majesty of the other part.

WHEREAS

the Person selected has been duly selected for appointment as

(hereinafter called the Person selected)

to the Dependency of \_\_\_\_\_ (hereinafter called the Dependency) and will be  
reconciled with a passage thereto, and may, if he is on his first tour of service and in respect of a salary of  
one thousand five hundred pounds a year or less, be paid an outfit allowance of £30/- thirty pounds.

AND WHEREAS the Person selected may hereafter be granted leave of absence from the Dependency  
known as "return leave" or "return sick leave" and may receive pay in respect of such leave.

NOW the Person selected in consideration of the premises, doth hereby agree that should he fail to  
return to the Dependency as and when directed, or prior to the expiration of the tour of service that shall  
have been fixed by the Officer Administering the Government of the Dependency either quit the Dependency  
without permission or leave the service of the Government of the Dependency or be dismissed or removed  
from his appointment in consequence of misconduct, he will refund and repay to the Government of the  
Dependency or to the Crown Agents for the Colonies in London the amount paid for his passage to the  
Dependency and transport to his post and the amount paid for outfit allowances or such part of it as the Officer  
Administering the Government of the Dependency or the Secretary of State may direct.

PROVIDED always that nothing herein contained shall bind or oblige the Person selected to repay the  
aforesaid amounts if at the time he shall leave the service of the Government of the Dependency as aforesaid,  
the Officer Administering the Government of the Dependency or person acting as such, shall certify that the  
Person selected is unable from bodily or mental infirmity to continue in the performance of his duty.

AND the Person selected in consideration of the premises, doth hereby also agree that should he fail  
on any occasion after the expiry of such return leave or return sick leave as aforesaid, duly to return to the  
Dependency for further service under the Government of the Dependency or to take up service under the  
Government of any other East African Dependency if transferred, or should he return to the expiration of the tour  
of service that shall have been fixed by the Officer Administering the Government of the Dependency either  
quit the Dependency in which he is serving without the permission of the Officer Administering the Government,  
or leave the service of the Government of the Dependency, or be dismissed or removed from the service in con-  
sequence of misconduct, he will refund and repay to the Government of the Dependency in which he is  
serving or to the Crown Agents for the Colonies, on demand, the whole and part of the amount or amounts  
which may have been paid to him or on his behalf in respect of such leave as the Officer Administering the  
Government of the Dependency or the Secretary of State shall direct, and also the whole or such part of the  
cost of his passage to the Dependency as the Officer Administering the Government thereof, or the Secretary of  
State shall direct.
