From THE DIRECTOR OF INTELLIGENCE.

Confidential.

The Director of Intelligence presents his compliments to the Under Secretary of State for the Colonies and begs leave to say that he has received a report to the effect that at a secret Conference held in Moscow recently it was decided to organise Communist propaganda in certain British Colonies and that one, Jaworsky, was detailed for Mombasa, Robert Wylie for Zanzibar and Henry Andersen for ^{Uganda} Bangassie. Sir Basil Thomson hopes to be able to send further information in this matter in a few days. If the persons mentioned should attempt to land in these Colonies it would be well to refuse them a landing.
