With reference to Mr. Churchill's Confidential despatch of the 18th October last, I have the honour to refer to the latter part of paragraph C of my despatch, Confidential No.236 of 7th September, 1922, and to submit for your approval a recommendation from the General Manager, Uganda Railway, that the balance of £4,841 on the £375,000 loan which remains after transfer of £30,251 to cover the over expenditure on the £250,000 loan, be utilized for the construction and erection of horse boxes and luggage vans, the material for which has been lying in the country for some time.
