advice given to the Trans-Zambezi

It is very doubtful how far the
terms of issue will depend in any way
on the showing which we are able to
make in the Prospectus, but, from our
point of view, that consideration is of
great importance. We certainly shall
not be able to make as good a show now
as we could have done in May last and
nothing we could say about a revival of
trade would be in very general terms.
I do not think we should take the matter
up even as a preliminary step, until we
receive the draft estimates for 1923
and are able to form some opinion of
what the financial position of the
Colon really is.
