

I have the honour to refer you to your communication of the 27th June 1921, numbered 5817/11821 and addressed to Mr. Reid, a Director of this Company, in which you were good enough to inform us that certain instructions had been forwarded to the Governors of African Territories with a view to this Company's expedition being given German facilities.

I have the honour to inform you that the application referred to has been carried out with considerable success and that thanks to the kind offices and courtesy of the English Administration and their facilities enabled us to procure the making of a most interesting series of pictures, of which the full value has been assessed.

On the 1st August I made my return to Bulawayo, and on the 2nd August I reached the Victoria Falls.

On the 3rd August I started for the Victoria Falls. Several months were spent in the making of a very complete series of pictures mainly in the districts of Lusaka, Loco-oco, and Dar-es-Salaam. The railway from Mombasa to Nairobi was traversed on foot, and a number of other districts were visited and a series of pictures made.

On the 1st October I started for the various islands of the Zambezi River, and had the pleasure to spend some time at the Island of Rhodesia, and later, thanks to the kind offices of the British Consul General, to the Island of Zanzibar, where a number of pictures were made.

Several months were spent in the country and a very complete series of pictures was taken. Mtozoro, Mtozoro, and Marra-Salama. Great Victoria Falls and Moshi was traversed on foot and a complete series of pictures made.

At present we are engaged in the production of a series of 3000 ft. of film to be used in our projector. We are to open 2000 ft. of film in the Victoria Falls and 1000 ft. in the Lake, thanks to the kind assistance of the Government and other materials, we hope to have the projector ready by the end of October.
