My Lord Duke,

I have the honour to apply for Your Grace's sanction to make certain alterations in the boundary between Ulu Native Reserve and Machakos Township.

2. Machakos Township was gazetted in 1906 as the area comprised within a circle having a radius of $\frac{1}{2}$ mile with the Collector's Office as centre. It is desired to replace this description by a more definite and convenient one.

3. The area of the present township is 1189 acres while the area within the proposed boundary will be 1152 acres. The Native Reserve will thus be increased by 37 acres.

4. I enclose a description of the boundary and a blue print showing the proposed alterations.

5. The proposed change has the approval of the native authorities concerned.

MACHAKOS TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY

Commencing at the most westerly corner of L.O.No. 1791 (Machakos Industrial School) on the River Mtoni, or Mtoni, which forms the south-western boundary of that portion;

thence bounded by that river down-stream for about 800 feet to a point bearing $92^{\circ} 23' 24''$ from a beacon approximately 218 feet therefrom;

thence westerly bearing $272^{\circ} 23' 24''$ through that beacon for a distance of approximately 6286 feet to a beacon;

thence south-easterly bearing $144^{\circ} 14' 22''$ for approximately 1369 feet to a beacon;

thence south-westerly bearing $209^{\circ} 26' 33''$ for approximately 6732 feet to a beacon;

thence southerly bearing $189^{\circ} 06' 33''$ for about 6800 feet to the River Murengoni;

thence by that river up-stream to the north-east corner of L.O.No. 358;

thence easterly ~~east~~ bearing of $96^{\circ} 38' 08''$ for about 2200 feet to a beacon;

thence still easterly ~~east~~ bearing $83^{\circ} 38' 31''$ for approximately 6690 feet to a beacon;

thence still easterly ~~east~~ bearing of $80^{\circ} 34' 57''$ for approximately 1341 feet to a beacon;

thence northerly ~~east~~ bearing of $1^{\circ} 48' 20''$ for approximately 5697 feet to a beacon;

thence easterly ~~east~~ bearing of $91^{\circ} 02' 32''$ for approximately 5047 feet to the River Mtoni;

thence by that river down-stream to the point of commencement.

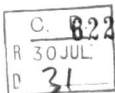
