In reply to the inquiry contained in Your Grace's Confidential despatch of 30th April, 1923, I have the honour to report that the Acting Governor investigated the possibility of effecting reductions in the establishment of the Administrator General's Department as directed by Your Grace in commenting upon Head XII of the current year's estimates.

2. No doubt exists that the duties in that Department should they remain on the present basis render a second officer a permanent necessity. Mr. Heaven has obtained a satisfactory medical certificate and has accordingly been confirmed with effect from the date of his first appointment, namely the 5th of April, 1921.

3. I take this opportunity of informing Your Grace that a scheme whereby the present duties of the Administrator General will be absorbed by and combined with the duties of a Registrar General is now under consideration. It is believed that the appointment of a Registrar General, who would also assume the post of Official Receiver, would be productive of revenue considerably greater than the anticipated increase
