131 March 13th Your telegram 3rd February
Administrator Dar-es-Salaam reports that condition
of rails fair rolling stock poor. Uganda
Railway estimates value of permanent way material
at Kilwa £200 per mile and prepared to offer this
price for serviceable material only and provided
that shipping facilities can be arranged but
suggest that reduction in this price might be made
owing to difficulty and cost of shipping to
Kilindini. Representative of Uganda Railway to be
sole judge of condition of material. Any rolling
stock found serviceable to be given free of cost.

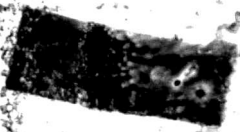
