I have the honour to report that I have approved the ~~Expenditure~~ of £240 for which provision is being made in the Estimates for the erection of new beacons on Kilindini Shoal and Buchanan Rock in Kilindini Harbour.

2. The present tripods are fast rusting away with sea, and it is very necessary that dangers to navigation should be efficiently marked by concrete ~~beacons~~. I trust that my action will meet with Your Lordship's approval.

3. A further requirement of the Port Department is the engagement of an additional European Pilot. In the absence of Mr. Sergeant on leave, there only remains one European Pilot to deal with the increased shipping. The earnings of the pilotage service makes this branch more than self-supporting and unless Pilots are available loss of revenue will result to the Protect-
orate and the repute of the Port will suffer if vessels


