I have the honour to acknowledge Your Lordship's despatch Confidential of 8th July regarding petrol and paraffin supplies for the Uganda Protectorate and for this Colony and to inform Your Lordship that, shortly after the Governor's return from England, he paid a visit to Mombasa and was able to discuss the question of sites for the erection of godowns for petrol storage very fully with the local representative of Messrs. Smith McKenzie and Company and other interested parties.

2. As a result of these discussions applications have now been invited from the public for the lease of plots at Mombasa, Nairobi Nakuru and elsewhere for this purpose at a nominal rental. It is to be hoped that, should any further shortage of petrol occur in the future it will not be possible to attribute this
