With reference to your letter of the 4th ultimo, No. 22875/1920, regarding the Reverend T.S.R. Westgate, late Chaplain, East Africa Local Forces, I am directed to acquaint you, for the information of the Secretary of State, that this Department has been informed by the Officer Paying Imperial Pensions, Ottawa, Canada, that temporary retired pay at the rate of 287.10.0 a year has been issued to the Officer for the quarter ending March 31st, and that payment is being continued, on the authority of the letter from your Department of the 25th November last, No. 57235.

The Officer Paying Imperial Pensions has, therefore, been advised of the duration of the award (i.e. from the 1st January 1920 to the 28th January 1921), and has been requested to claim refund of the total amounts paid by him, through His Majesty's Paymaster-General, who will effect the necessary adjustment with the Crown Agents for the Colonies.
