Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 4th instant, No. 35184/20, with enclosures, in the case of Mr. P. E. Egan, late Company Sergeant Major, East African Military Labour Corps, I am directed by the Minister of Pensions to inform you that on the presumption that the period of the original award was amended by the Governor of the East African Protectorate, in accordance with Ministry Letter No. M/Gen/1450 dated 6th August, 1919, as embodied in your Despatch of 26th idem, the renewal award at the 20% rate should take effect from 24th February, 1920, i.e. the day after date of expiry of first award.

I am to add, however, that the misunderstanding arose through the statement in the Despatch from the Governor of the East African Protectorate dated 20th November, 1919, to the effect that Company Sergeant Major Egan's pension had lapsed on 24th August, 1919, which would not appear to indicate
