With reference to my telegram of July 8th and other correspondence respecting the transference of the Bombay Agency to a business firm. I have the honour to suggest the following proportional basis for the calculation of the annual payment of office to Messrs. Mackinnon, Mackensie and Company :-

East Africa Protectorate 9/12 Uganda 2/12 Nyasaland 1/12

- 2. If you accord your sanction to this proposal, the total annual expenditure for the East Africa Protectorate, on the basis of the figures given by the Agent General for 1911-12. would be: "Office Expenses" £300, plus "Commission" £235, viz: a total of £535 as compared with the sum of £851 provided in this year's Estimates.
- 3. I may add that I have received from the Government of Uganda and Nyasaland an expression of their concurrence in this suggestion.
