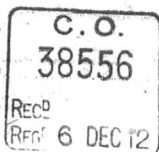

Sir,

I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Read's letter of the 26th ultimo (36688/1912) and its accompanying copy of a despatch from the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate, with its enclosure, respecting the creation of a new grade of Indian Assistants in the Forestry Department in that Protectorate.

In reply I am to request you to inform Mr. Secretary Harcourt that, in the circumstances represented, My Lords approve provision being made in the Estimates of the Protectorate for 1913/14 for the appointment of one Indian Assistant Forester with pay at the rate of Rs. 100 by Rs. 10 to Rs. 200 per mensem and the usual privileges of the Asiatic Staff.
