With reference to your letter No. 14100/1912 of the 17th of May last, on the subject of Colonel Sir E.P.C.Girouard retaining the Governorship of the East Africa Protectorate beyond the 3rd of February, 1913, I am commanded by the Army Council to inform you that this officer has now applied to retire from the Army, and the necessary steps are being taken in the matter.

The Council have therefore no objection to the services of Sir P.Girouard remaining at the disposal of your Department, after his retirement for the above employment, but his Civil emoluments will be liable to a deduction of not less than 10 per cent under the provisions of Rule 4 of Appendix II of the Pay Warrant.
