Protectorate SEND GREETING WHEREAS the Government of
the East Africa Protectorate is compelling us to leave
the Laikipia district which was granted to the Masai
by His Majesty's late Commissioner Sir Donald Stewart,
K.C.M.G., as their freehold for ever AND WHEREAS
we desire to take all legal and proper steps to main-
tain for ourselves and the other members of the Masai
tribe our and their rights to the said district AND
WHEREAS we have appointed Mr.H.W.Buckland of Nakuru
to be our solicitor and A.Morrison Esquire and A.D.Home
Esquire Barristers-at-Law Mombasa to be our counsel in
this Protectorate AND WHEREAS the said Mr.H.W.Buckland
has appointed Messrs.Bischoff and Company, 4, Great
Winchester Street, London, E.C. to be our London Agents
NOW KNOW YE that we hereby ratify and confirm the
appointment of the said Messrs.Bischoff and Company to
be our London Agents with full power in our name and on



