 K.C.M.G., as their freehold for ever AND WHEREAS
 we desire to take all legal and proper steps to main-
 tain for ourselves and the other members of the Masai
 tribe our and their rights to the said district AND
WHEREAS we have appointed Mr. H. W. Buckland of Nakuru
 to be our solicitor and A. Morrison Esquire and A. D. Home

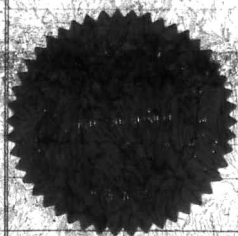
