Mr Frederick Plummer, Guard on the Uganda Railway was killed in a railway accident at Kikuyu Station on the 22nd December 1912. He was Guard in charge of a Goods train on the date in question which train was parted on a steep grade owing to the inability of the engine to pull the whole of the train. The front portion was taken to the Station ahead and before the engine returned, the rear part ran back and derailed just outside Kikuyu Station. The wagons were overturned and Guard Plummer's body was found underneath one of them.
