18th July. I have received your cypher telegram of the 15th July as regards the Marahan. There are no grounds for anxiety and any situation which may arise. should be capable of being dealt with by the troops on the spot.

On May the 8th, on the recommendation of the local authorities, the disarmament of the Marahan was approved, after the submission of one section and the delivery of their arms.

Unless the Abyssinian Government take measures to prevent their own subjects from crossing into our territory for the purpose of recovering the Boran refugees the situation in the North may become serious. The Moyale garrison is insufficient for the protection of the Boran and reinforcements are not available. The situation should not however prove difficult it a firm attitude is adopted by the Abyssinian Covernment.
